Program

- Day 1** Arrive in Anchorage and transfer to hotel. *Overnight in Anchorage.*
- Day 2** Grand adventure to Valdez. Ride through the Matanuska Susitna Valley, where world-record vegetables grow in the 24-hour daylight. Stop by Worthington Glacier. Early evening arrival into Valdez, nestled between the waterfront and mountains, giving it the nickname, Alaska's Little Switzerland. Included entrance to the Valdez Museum. *Overnight Valdez.*
- Day 3** In late morning, board a glacier and wildlife cruise. Travel through majestic Prince William Sound. Explore the three-mile face of the mighty Columbia Glacier, and hear tales of the region as told by the Alaskan crew. Keep your eyes open for seals, sea lions, otters, whales, and puffins throughout this half-day exploration cruise. *Overnight Valdez.*

- Day 4** Motorcoach journey north to Fairbanks, the largest city in the interior. The route takes you along the Wrangell-St. Elias National Park, the largest park in the U.S. and the Trans-Alaska Pipeline. *Overnight Fairbanks.*
- Day 5** Learn how the gold rush affected Alaska’s interior on a sightseeing tour with an included visit to the University of Alaska Fairbanks Museum. There’s time for shopping, walking or dining on your own downtown. Cruise on the Chena River aboard a sternwheeler, 1800s-style. Tonight, partake in an authentic salmon bake (optional). *Overnight Fairbanks.*
- Day 6** Ride south to Denali National Park. Explore this pristine area at your leisure, either on a complimentary park service activity or an optional tour, such as wild river rafting, flightseeing to Mt. McKinley, or jet boat safari.
- Day 7** Travel deep into Denali National Park on the Tundra Wilderness Tour and search the pristine wilderness for bear, moose, caribou, and Dall sheep. This daylong journey is narrated, providing insight into the flora and fauna of this spectacular region. *Overnight Denali.*
- Day 8** Morning at leisure. In the afternoon, board the world-famous Alaska Railroad for the scenic day-trip to Anchorage. *Overnight Anchorage.*
- Day 9** Enjoy a brief city tour of Anchorage, which includes the historic downtown district and a visit to the Alaska Native Heritage Center. Tonight, feast on an Alaskan-style meal. *Overnight Anchorage.*
- Day 10** Transfer to airport for departure flight.
